PROCLAMATION

WHERE AS: Severe storms and flooding that occurred on April 26, 2017, and continuing caused great damage to private property and public facilities in various jurisdictions in Arkansas; and

WHERE AS: Adverse circumstances have been brought to bear upon the citizens and properties within the State; and

WHERE AS: Arkansas state chartered banks have had their operations severely disrupted by the storms and flooding; and

WHERE AS: Governor Asa Hutchinson declared a State of Emergency; and

HERE AS: With the consent of the Governor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Candace A. Franks, Bank Commissioner of the State of Arkansas, acting under the authority vested in me by Ark. Code Ann. § 23-46-212, as amended, do hereby declare a State of Emergency in Randolph County, Arkansas.

ORDER

In accordance with A.C.A. § 23-46-212, The Arkansas Bank Commissioner, with the consent of the Governor, declared a State of Emergency in Randolph County, Arkansas, on May 1, 2017, due to the severe storms and floods which commenced on April 26, 2017. The Arkansas Bank Commissioner finds that **RiverBank, Pocahontas, Arkansas**, has been significantly impacted and normal business operations cannot be conducted at RiverBank's Pocahontas location because of flooding. Therefore, pursuant to the authority granted by A.C.A § 23-46-212(e)(1)(A), it is hereby ORDERED that RiverBank, Pocahontas, Arkansas, is hereby approved to open a temporary office in Randolph County, Arkansas, to help meet the credit, deposit, and other financial needs of the customers in the affected area.

This ORDER shall remain in effect for one hundred twenty (120) days or until terminated by the Commissioner.
